

**ORDER AND NOTICE
OF A GENERAL/JOINT ELECTION
IN THE CITY OF PORT ARTHUR,
JEFFERSON COUNTY, TEXAS**

Notice is hereby given that the City of Port Arthur will hold a General/Joint Election for the purpose of electing Councilmembers for Districts 1, 2, 3, 4 and At-Large Positions 5 and 6 in conjunction with the Port Arthur Independent School District and the Sabine Pass Port Authority on Saturday, May 6, 2023, between the hours 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.

I, Thurman Bartie, Mayor of the City of Port Arthur, Texas, as authorized by the City Council, do hereby Order and give Notice of a General/Joint Election to be held in the City of Port Arthur, Texas, on Saturday, May 6, 2023, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., for the purpose of electing Councilmembers for Districts 1, 2, 3, 4 and At-Large Positions 5 and 6.

The term of office for Districts 1, 2, 3 & 4 shall be for three years, and At-Large Positions 5 & 6 shall be for a period of four years and until his/her respective successor shall have been elected and duly qualified. Candidates may file an application with the City Secretary for a place on the ballot beginning January 18, 2023 through February 17, 2023 at 5:00 p.m.

Said election shall be by Electronic Voting System as provided in Section 123.001 of the Election Code, Section 9.004, et eq., Local Government Code and the City Charter. The location of each polling place is shown in Exhibit "A-1". Early voting by personal appearance will be conducted each weekday at the following locations between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. beginning on Monday, April 24, 2023 and ending on Tuesday, May 2, 2023:
